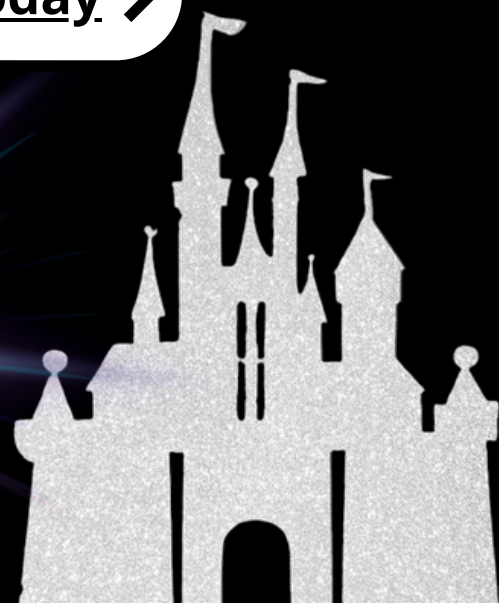

Welcome to USA ICON

We are honored to welcome your child into the **ICONIC Princess Program**, a mentorship-based experience designed to introduce young girls to confidence, leadership, and positive self-expression in a fun, structured, and uplifting environment.

This program gives each participant the opportunity to experience a **national stage**, build meaningful relationships, and begin developing the qualities that define a true USA ICON.

What Does ICON Mean

At USA ICON, our name represents the foundation of who we are and what we stand for:

- **Intelligent** – She embraces knowledge and wisdom
- **Confident** – In her abilities and convictions
- **Optimistic** – Sees possibilities in everyone and every situation
- **Noble** – in character, she leads by example

These values are intentionally woven into every part of this program from mentorship to stage experience, so each participant begins to understand what it truly means to be an ICON.

Qualifications & Opportunity

The **USA ICON Princess Program** is a mentorship-based experience designed for young girls ages **Kindergarten** (must be potty trained) **through 9 years old**, giving them the opportunity to be part of a fun-filled and meaningful week during **USA ICON Nationals**.

This program introduces young girls to the USA ICON organization, while allowing them to experience the excitement of a national-level event in an age-appropriate and uplifting environment. Each participant will be paired with a USA ICON titleholder. If a participant does not have a specific Queen, one will be assigned to ensure every child feels included and supported.

Throughout the week, participants will perform a production princess dance number on stage during **both preliminary competitions and the final show**, giving them real stage exposure and the opportunity to perform in front of a live audience. When not participating, families will have the opportunity to enjoy the show and experience the excitement of USA ICON Nationals.

This is a **mentorship-based, performance-focused program** integrated into USA ICON Nationals.

Sign-Making Party

Participants will create signs to support and celebrate their Queen during competitions, reinforcing positivity and teamwork.

Production Number Rehearsals

Participants will learn a choreographed routine performed during all shows.

Optional Competition (optional)

The opportunity to take the stage alongside the USA ICON titleholders who are also participating in optional competitions. This provides a fun, low-pressure environment for participants to confidently showcase their personality, presence, and individuality.

Rules & Regulations

- Each participant in the USA ICON Princess Program must be between Kindergarten (potty-trained) - 9 years old
- Participants must be of good moral character and maintain conduct that reflects the values and standards of the USA ICON Pageant System.
- All decisions regarding eligibility, rules, scoring, and participation shall be determined solely by the USA ICON Pageant System and are final.
- Any participant, parent, family member, guest, or affiliate displaying unsportsmanlike conduct, inappropriate behavior, bullying, harassment, or negativity toward contestants, staff, judges, sponsors, or the organization may result in immediate dismissal from the program without refund.



- Participants and their parent/legal guardian agree to liability waiver, hold harmless and release the USA ICON Pageant System, its officers, directors, staff, volunteers, sponsors, affiliates, and representatives from any and all claims, damages, liabilities, injuries, losses, or expenses arising from participation in any USA ICON event, activity, competition, appearance, rehearsal, or related function.
- By participating, contestants grant the USA ICON Pageant System the irrevocable right to use their name, photograph, image, likeness, voice, video footage, biography, and submitted materials for promotional, advertising, social media, livestream, website, sponsorship, and commercial purposes without compensation or further approval.
- All understand and agree that portions or all of the competition and related events may be photographed, livestreamed, videotaped, televised, or otherwise distributed through media platforms by the USA ICON Pageant System.
- All fees paid to the USA ICON Pageant, including but not limited to registration fees, entry fees, sponsorships, advertisements, optional competitions, tickets, program book purchases, and merchandise, are strictly NON-REFUNDABLE and NON-TRANSFERABLE under any circumstances. This includes withdrawal, dismissal, scheduling conflicts, illness, emergencies, or acts beyond the organization's control.
- Contestants and parents/guardians acknowledge that submission of an application and/or participation in the USA ICON Pageant System constitutes full understanding and acceptance of all rules, regulations, policies, and expectations established by the organization.

- A parent or guardian must be **present and responsible** for their child unless otherwise specified
 - All rehearsals and activities are **closed** to parents/guardians. (Unless medical accommodations are granted) Parents will be required to drop off their child at the scheduled start time and pick them up promptly at the conclusion of scheduled activities.
- Please ensure your child:
 - Arrives on time
 - Is prepared for each activity
 - Is ready to participate fully

STEM

- Description: Showcase your involvement or achievements in Science, Technology, Engineering, or Mathematics.
- Requirements: Submit a brief essay (250-500 words) detailing your STEM projects, achievements, or aspirations. Include any relevant documentation or evidence of your work.

Arts

- Description: Highlight your artistic talents and contributions, whether in visual arts, performing arts, or other creative fields.
- Requirements: Provide a portfolio or video showcasing your artwork or performances. Include a short description of each piece or performance.

Heart of Service

- Description: Demonstrate your commitment to community service and making a positive impact.
- Requirements: Submit a report or summary (250-500 words) of your community service activities, including the organizations you've worked with, your role, and the outcomes of your service.

Business Babe

- Description: Highlight your entrepreneurial spirit and business achievements.
- Requirements: Provide a business plan or a detailed report (250-500 words) of your business or entrepreneurial project. Include any relevant metrics or achievements.

Songwriter

- Description: Be the next Taylor Swift by showcasing your talent in songwriting.

- Requirements: Submit a current resume with a focus on your accomplishments, skills, and experiences. Include any certifications or awards.

Academic Achievement

- Description: Showcase your academic excellence and accomplishments.
- Requirements: Provide a summary (250-500 words) of your academic achievements, including any awards, honors, or special projects. Include supporting documentation if available.

Love for My Sport

- Description: Share your passion and achievements in your chosen sport.
- Requirements: Submit a report or video (2-3 minutes) detailing your involvement in the sport, including your training, achievements, and personal reflections.

Portfolio

- Description: Showcase your modeling versatility, creativity, and personal style through a curated portfolio. Titleholders will be judged on their ability to express emotion, connect with the camera, and display professionalism in diverse themes and looks.
- Requirements: Portfolio Submission submit 5-10 professional photos with different themes (fashion, casual, editorial, etc.).

Optional show competitions to maximize your pageant experience! Gain extra chances to win awards, enjoy additional onstage practice, and refine your performance. Stand out from the competition and make a lasting impression. Don't miss this opportunity to shine!

Fun Fashion

- Description: Showcase your unique style in an outfit that truly represents your personality! Whether it's chic dress, trendy pants and top, playful shorts, or a dramatic high-low ensemble, capes, trains, let your creativity shine. The highest-scoring outfits will dazzle with a surprise factor or a wow effect that captures the judges' attention and showcases your flair for fashion.
- Requirement: Wear an outfit that reflects your individuality and personal style. The more memorable and original, the better!

Red Carpet Interview

- Description: Step into the spotlight and channel your inner celebrity for this glamorous on-stage press conference. Imagine you're a star at your favorite red-carpet event and engage with the audience as if



you're answering questions from top reporters. This is your moment to shine and showcase your poise, charisma, and star power.

- Requirement: Act as if you're a high-profile celebrity on the red carpet. Be engaging, confident, and show off your best interview skills.

Casual Wear

- Description: Embrace relaxed elegance in this competition designed to highlight your personal style in casual wear. Whether you opt for a chic jumpsuit, stylish jeans and a blouse, or a laid-back yet fashionable outfit, the key is to exude confidence and comfort while looking effortlessly stylish.
- Requirement: Wear a casual outfit that balances comfort with style, showcasing your ability to look polished even in relaxed settings.

State Pride Costume

Talent (NEW)

- Description: Step into the spotlight and showcase your unique talent in this exciting on-stage competition. Whether it's dance, singing, acting, cheer, spoken word, martial arts, playing an instrument, or another special skill, this is your moment to entertain the audience and captivate the judges with your confidence, creativity, and stage presence. Performances should be energetic, polished, and reflect your personality while creating an unforgettable "wow" moment on stage.
- Requirement: Contestants will perform a talent routine with a maximum time limit of 60–90 seconds. Performances should be age-appropriate, family-friendly, and highlight the contestant's individuality, confidence, and performance ability.

Independent Optional Events



Independent optionals are separate competitions held during the week of the main pageant. Each optional is judged independently and does not impact the main competition scores, so titleholders can participate freely.

Board Room Interview

- **Description:** Engage in a practice private interview one-on-one with a panel of judges to demonstrate your communication skills, critical thinking, and professionalism. This private session will assess your ability to articulate thoughts and handle high-level discussions. This you will receive judges' feedback.
- **Requirements:** Prepare to discuss personal achievements and relevant topics, dress in business professional attire, and demonstrate clear communication. Bring any necessary notes, be punctual, and keep all interview content confidential.

Cover Model

- **Description:** Showcase your modeling skills in the Cover Model Shoot. A photographer will capture 10-20 frames of each Titleholder, focusing on your ability to pose confidently and naturally. Impress with your charisma and versatility to stand out as the best model.
- **Requirements:** Showcase strong modeling skills with confident poses and expressions. Wear an outfit that enhances your on-camera presence and maintain a professional attitude throughout.
